

NOTE: Online Internal Marks entry, Application submission and fee payment is a must through **pmb.campusuite.in**. If the college authorities fail to submit through online, it will not be considered for examination.

2. Examination Applications Fee Structure Details:

- Hard copy of the IA marks report, Examination application & fee paid receipt must be submitted to the Board on or before **23.04.2025 at 5.30 p.m** without fail.
